

#### **EXHIBITOR INFORMATION**

**ARENA POLICY:** There will be no lunging at all in the main warm up arena whenever a session is going on, and 30 minutes before any session. Horses being ridden or driven will take precedence over those being lunged whenever working. Please use outdoor space for lunging whenever possible.

The warm up and show rings are both comprised mixed footing with sand, loam and tanbark. The show arena is 100' X 200'.

**ARRIVALS:** Horses will be allowed in to the show grounds, and stalls will be available at **8:00** am on **Tuesday**, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. In special cases, early arrivals may be arranged for Monday afternoon at the rate of \$25 extra per stall. Permission must be requested for early arrival.

**BEDDING:** Bedding must be purchased through the horse show at the rate of \$10. per bag. For pre-bedding orders, to have your bedding delivered, and even to have your stalls bedded for you prior to your arrival, please contact **Sandy Sessink at 248-207-4956**. Pre-bedding is service \$12 per stall. And, please be aware, shavings ordered after the first day of the show will be delivered and billed at the rate of \$11 per bag.

BOX SEATS: Please see the form this for included in prize list information regarding Sponsor's Sky Lounge seating. Tables will be available with some of our sponsorship levels. These will be located up on the mezzanine along with Ken Martin's photo booth and other vendors

**CAMPING:** There is a campground directly across the street from the Michiana Event



Center. The cost is \$35 per night, and you will pay the campgrounds directly.

CLASS HOLD POLICY: Holds must be requested at least one hour prior to the session. Anyone with special requests for more than a standard two minute hold must make special arrangement with the show manager. Once a hold is granted, it will not be lifted.

Please note, the deadline of March 15<sup>th</sup> will remain the same for this method of entering. During the horse show, all post entries must be made 90 minutes prior to the session of the class you are entering.

#### **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**

1) All horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza and Equine Herpes Virus Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the grounds upon request by Competition Management.

2) All horses entering the grounds must also be accompanied by documentation of a negative Coggins test for EIA within the previous 12 months.

3) All out-of-state horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Interstate Health Papers dated no more than 10 days before the show.

HOST HOTEL: The Indiana Spring Classic has made special arrangements with the Blue Gate Garden Inn for special group rates for our exhibitors. Please call them for reservations, and ask for the Spring Classic Horse Show rate. Please remember, pets are not allowed at the the Blue Gate. The Super 8 does allow dogs.

**PRIZES:** Trophies and 6 ribbons will be awarded in all qualifying classes and championships, including academy classes.

#### **REFUND POLICY:**

All entry and stall fees will be refunded on request prior to the closing date for entries of March 22<sup>nd</sup>. After this date, refunds will only be made upon verification of a bona fide injury to horse, exhibitor, or exhibitor's family. This verification must be presented by the first day of the show. 2. Stall fees will not be refunded for any reason after March 29<sup>th</sup>. 3. Office fees are not refundable for any reason.

**SHOW OFFICE HOURS:** The show office will be located in the hallway to the right of the entrance to the show arena. The office will be open on Tuesday afternoon, and most of the day on Wednesday. Absolutely no entries will be accepted within the hour prior to the beginning of any session.

STALLS: Stalls are permanent wood structures with solid sliding doors. Due to sudden, significant increases in facility costs at the Michiana Event Center, we have had to adjust the show's price for stalls accordingly. The new price of \$165 per stall is a considerable, but necessary increase for the show. Fortunately, the value of our safe, convenient stabling in a clean, climate-controlled facility remains at the highest level.

**STALL MATS:** Our official stall mat company, serving the Indiana Spring Classic will be Showtime Stall Mat Company. For your horse's comfort, you can have their stalls matted with thick rubber for the very reasonable rate of \$75 per stall! And you don't have to do a thing! It's all done for you before you arrive, and taken away after you have left. Please contact Sandy Sessink to sign up for this great, convenient service!

#### USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized <sub>5</sub>vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. other Wheelchairs and mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

#### **USEF REQUIREMENTS**

This show is licensed by USEF as a Competition Lite.

- Owners and riders are not required to be members of the Federation, but any competing member, 18 or older must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition.
- Anyone signing as trainer on the entry form, must be a competing member of USEF and must have completed the SafeSport Training prior to the first day of competition.
- Drug fees are not charged at a Competition Lite show, but any horse is subject to testing. Medication forms must be filed electronically.
- Lite Competitions will award half-value HOTY points to all USEF recorded horses, whose owner is a competing member.







#### **Academy Division Rules**

Riders in this division are students who are currently taking lessons and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. The age of the rider must be listed on the entry blank. Headers for lead line riders must be at least 18 years of age. Horses that are used are to be lesson horses (see horse eligibility). Horses are not to be judged.

**Rider Eligibility:** A rider may not enter in any other division at the show. A rider who has shown in a regular division or in a full riding suit at any show is prohibited from participating further in the Academy Division, with the exception of the Show Rider Classes. Once a rider has competed at any level wearing a full suit, they are ineligible to compete in academy classes at any point thereafter; the rider can however show in Show Rider Classes in the season(s) following the season in which the rider showed wearing a full suit.

**Horse Eligibility:** All horses/ponies used in Academy classes must be used regularly in lesson programs. All breeds are welcome. Horses used in Tournament classes may cross enter into the regular horse show classes with different riders.

**Equipment:** Horses may be shown in work bridles (martingales allowed), Pelham bridles, or full bridles. There are no shoeing restrictions or requirements. Protective boots are allowed.

**Rider Attire:** Helmets approved for horseback riding (not bicycle helmets) are mandatory for all exhibitors. Riders must wear appropriate boots.

Driving Class: Drivers MUST be accompanied, in the cart, by a professional.
